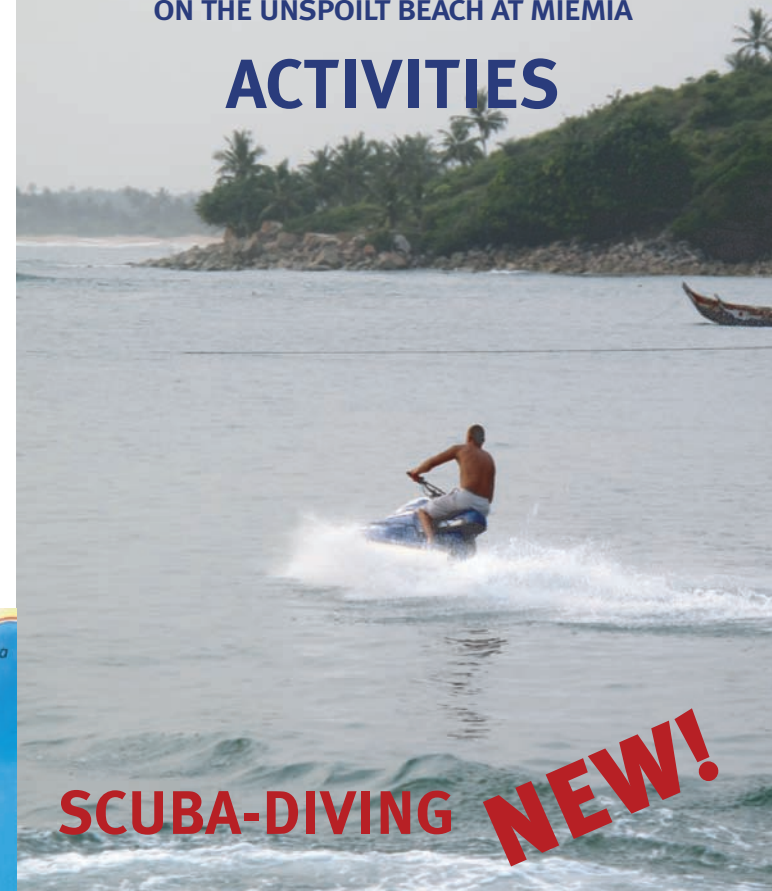

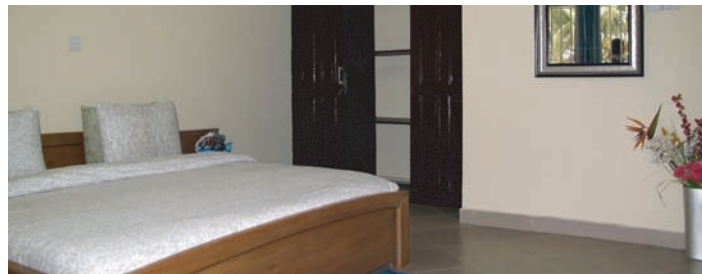

There are a large variety of activities available on our beautiful beach at Miemia. We rent out snorkelling equipment, fishing rods, harpoons, jet skis, kayaks and a small "Zodiac" for kids.

Our high-class hard boat, powered by a 400 horsepower engine, gets you out onto the open sea in no time at all. In season you can watch humpback whales close at hand as they rear their calves in the bay.

NEARBY SIGHTS

The west coast of Ghana has many interesting cultural sights to offer. There are numerous slave forts that are well preserved and worth viewing. Visit a typical Ghanaian stilted village by canoe. A nature walk on a suspension bridge 40 metres above the tree-tops of the rainforest offers fantastic views of the fauna and flora from a completely different perspective.
